

Bumrah's 5 wicket haul rattles South Africa as India seize control on day 1

Kolkata: India closed Day One of the first Test against South Africa at 37/1 in 20 overs and trail by 122 runs after Jasprit Bumrah's sharp five-wicket haul had earlier skittled the visitors for 159 at the Eden Gardens here on Friday.



Before bad light brought an early end to proceedings in the final session, India lost opener Yashvir Jaiswal cheaply. But K.L. Rahul (3 not out) and newly established number three Washington Sundar (six not out) ensured there was no further damage before stumps arrived.

when Kuldeep trapped Temba Bavuma with a clever leg-slip play, and Dhruv Jurel caught the inside edge to send the Proteas skipper for just three, as South Africa slipped from 57/0 to 71/3. From there, Mulder and de Zorzi showed grit against the spinners till lunch arrived. Post the lunch interval, Kuldeep and Bumrah set the tone immediately for India by maintaining relentless accuracy.

That relentlessness was rewarded when Wiaan Mulder's attempt to reverse-sweep Kuldeep ended in him being trapped plumb low, with the all-rounder also burning a wicket.

The pair batted cautiously, adding 19 runs in an unbroken start for the second wicket on a surface that continued to show variable bounce.

After South Africa elected to bat first, Ryan Rickelton and Aiden Markram negotiated the early overs with composure to bring up the fifty of the opening stand — the first such instance for the Proteas in India after 17 innings. Rickelton, fluent from the outset, punished a wayward Siraj for providing width by taking three boundaries off him. Markram, who got off the mark after facing 22 balls, settled in after a watchful beginning by hitting fours through gorgeous back foot and front foot

shots before leaving everyone dazed with his shimmey down the pitch to dispatch Axar for six over wide long-on. Bumrah, who had produced a few balls that ranged from climbing sharply to staying a touch low, got India back in the game with his double strike — getting a length ball to beat Rickelton's outside-edge and rattle his off stump. He then produced a rising delivery from short of length that forced Markram to play at it, and the shoulder edge of the bat was caught by a diving Rishabh Pant. South Africa's progress was further dented

Bumrah's inswinging kept low and came in off the totem from round the wicket to trap Tony de Zorzi for 24. Though Stubbs and Kyle Verreynne tried stabilising South Africa's innings, Siraj found his rhythm with some reverse swing and struck twice in the 45th over to remove Verreynne and Marco Jansen. While Verreynne was slow to bring his bat down and was trapped low by a nip-backer from Siraj, the pacer got one to tail in from length and casked Marco Jansen through the gate for a three-ball duck.

ISSF World Championship Esha Singh, Manu Bhaker in contention for finals after precision stage

Cairo: Esha Singh and Manu Bhaker are in strong contention for a place in the final of the women's 25m Sport Pistol event at the ISSF World Championship Rifle & Pistol 2025, currently underway at the Olympic Shooting Range in Cairo, Egypt. After the completion of the Precision stage on Thursday, Esha stands fourth while Manu is placed seventh among the lineup of 85 shooters.

Olympic medalist Manu shot 292-11x (98, 96, 98) to keep herself within striking distance of the leaders. The third Indian in the fray, Rishi Sarabot, is currently placed 56th with 284-7x (95, 96, 93). Asian Archery C'ships: Dhiraj wins men's recurve gold as India finish with 10 medals

Dhaka: Olympian archer Dhiraj Bommadevara clinched the gold medal in the men's recurve individual event after beating compatriot Rahul as India concluded its campaign at the Asian Archery Championships with a total of 10 medals here on Friday.

Dhiraj outplayed the fellow Indian Rahul 6-2 in the summit clash to win the top spot on the podium. After a tightly contested opening set that left the scores level at 1-1, Dhiraj gained the upper hand by securing the

second set 29-26 to move ahead 2-1. Rahul responded strongly, holding Dhiraj to a draw in the third set, though the overall score remained 3-1 in Dhiraj's favour. Dhiraj then closed out the match by winning the final set 28-26. Earlier in the day, Anika Bhakat secured a landmark victory by defeating Paris Olympics individual silver medalist Nam Su-hyeon of Korea 7-3 to

capture the women's recurve individual gold. In the semifinals, Anika outclassed five-time Olympian and fellow Indian Deepika Kumari 6-5 in a thrilling shoot-off. In the second semifinal, India's Sangeeta, who continued her steady rise after previous success at the Tashkent 2023 Asia Cup, lost to Nam Su-hyeon 0-6. Meanwhile, Sangeeta concluded her campaign in the recurve women's individual event with a bronze medal after upsetting Deepika 6-5 in the shoot-off in the bronze medal playoff.
