Belagavi : Chief Minister Siddaramaiah said that All those who come to the government hospital are from the poor and middle class. My goal is to build a government medical college and a multi-specialty hospital in every district to provide the best health service to them.

He spoke after inaugurating the super specialty hospital building constructed on the premises of the Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences and the construction work of the residential building for home doctors, inaugurating the Belgaum bus stand of the North West Karnataka Road Transport Corporation constructed with the Belgaum Smart City grant, and laying the foundation stone of various buildings in the new premises of Rani Channamma University's Hirebagevadi campus and the road works connecting the university's new campus from the national highway. It is not enough to just build a hospital building. We will also appoint specialist doctors accordingly. We have decided to fill the vacant posts, he said. Currently, the doctors of Prabhakar Kore's multi-specialty hospital are serving free of cost in the government specialty hospital. He said he congratulates Kore for this. Our government is providing opportunities and facilities to the lower classes in the direction of eradicating inequality. He said that we are formulating programs keeping in

mind the words that people from lower communities cannot come into the mainstream as long as there is inequality. Our government is formulating programs as per the wishes of Buddha-Basava-Gandhi-Ambedkar. It is everyone's wish that the development of society and the country is possible only when development reaches the most marginalized sections of society. Therefore, we are formulating welfare programs for everyone, Siddaramaiah explained.

He said that the benefits that I implemented for the first time as Chief Minister and the guarantees that have been implemented now have increased the purchasing power and per capita income of the people of the state and have made women economically empowered.

He said that if the poor are financially empowered, it will be possible to erase the caste system and inequality in society.

It is estimated that 10 lakh hectares of crops have been destroyed in the state due to 95 percent excess rainfall in eight districts of the state. He said that we have rushed to the aid of farmers, growers and cultivators by providing a record amount of compensation for this crop damage. Ministers Sharan Prakash Patil, Satish Jarkiholi, Lakshmi Hebbalkar, Ramalinga Reddy, M.C. Sudhakar and many dignitaries, elected representatives and officials were present.

Empowerment of the Disabled — A Joint Responsibility of Society and Government — NGOs with Humanity — Padma Shri Dr. C.N. Manjunath



Bengaluru: MP Padma Shri Dr. C.N. Manjunath said Around four to eight crore people are facing problems of disability today. Although the government has formulated several schemes for these problems, it is more the responsibility of the society. Speaking at the 9th N.S. Hema Memorial Award - 2025 ceremony organized by the 'Angavikalara Sangha (APD)' at the Dwarka Auditorium of M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, he said that despite the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016, everyone in the society should come forward and develop an attitude of providing encouragement, help and opportunities to the disabled. Despite government schemes, only if the attitude of the

society changes can the disabled enjoy equal rights. It is the responsibility of all of us to provide equal rights in education, employment and basic facilities."

He continued, "The Central Government has implemented several important schemes for the welfare of the disabled. Through Sugama Bharat Abhiyan, public places, government offices and transport system have been facilitated. Through Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation Scheme, rehabilitation and training have been provided. Through ADIP Scheme, necessary equipment and facilities are being provided free of cost or at subsidized rates. Higher education is being promoted through National Fellowship & Scholarship for Higher Education. In addition, necessary training for employment and self-reliance is being provided through various Skill Development Schemes. If their potential is recognized and encouraged in the society, they can give strength to the development of the country. This is not just a matter of law or planning, it is a humanitarian responsibility," he said.

BJP fielded Deve Gowda to counter Congress's five guarantees: Surjewala

Bengaluru: Randeep Singh Surjewala AICC Secretary and Karnataka Congress in-charge has alleged that The five five guarantees schemes implemented by the Congress government in Karnataka are not just pro-people schemes. Rather, they have upheld 'social justice' and brought about a change in the lives of crores of people. However, now the BJP has fielded former Prime Minister H.D. Deve Gowda to oppose the Congress' guarantees. Reacting to JDS supremo and former Prime Minister H.D. Deve Gowda's statement that the state's economic situation has deteriorated due to guarantee schemes, Surjewala said that the hatred between the BJP-JDS alliance knows no bounds. The BJP has left Deve Gowda alone to oppose these schemes that are a light to the lives of the people. He condemned such 'blind-sighted parties' and said that they should be ashamed. Transformation due to guarantees:

Surjewala, who gave statistics on the success of these schemes, explained the impact of guarantees on the lives of the common man. Shakti Yojana: Women have already taken more than 526 crore

free bus rides. For this, the government has spent Rs. 14,274.32 crore till April 1. Most importantly, the Shakti Yojana has been recorded in the prestigious Golden Book of World Records and has created a 'new world record' by increasing women's mobility, independence and ability to work.

Griha Lakshmi: Rs.2,000 is being transferred to the accounts of 1.23 crore women in the state every month, improving the financial status of 94 per cent of the families. The state government has so far spent Rs 50,005 crore on the Griha Lakshmi scheme. Griha Jyoti: 200 units of free electricity were provided to 1.64 crore households, resulting in 90 per cent of the families saving money and using it for 'other household needs'. The Congress government has spent Rs 18,139 crore on this scheme. Anna Bhagya: Griha Lakshmi, Griha Jyoti and Anna Bhagya (10 kg rice for 4.49 crore Kannadigas) schemes have increased family savings and strengthened economic prosperity. Rs 15,000 crore has been spent Yuva Nidhi: Unemployed youth have been empowered by providing monthly allowance of Rs.1,500-Rs.3,000.

Health and Education Key to Ending Poverty and Ignorance: Basavaraj Bommai



Gadag (Shirahatti), Oct 4: Former Chief Minister and MP Basavaraj Bommai emphasized that a country with strong health and education systems will remain free from poverty and ignorance. Speaking at Kadakola village in Shirahatti taluk, Gadag district, he said his dream is to see Karnataka achieve this vision through sustained efforts in education and healthcare. Bommai participated in the inauguration of new facilities at the Government Pre-University College, a village library (Arivu Kendra), Santhe Katte, a new HDFC branch, and unveiled the statue of Kranti Veera Sangolli Rayanna. He also laid the foundation stone for the Sri Beereswar Sabha Bhavan. Highlighting his previous initiatives, Bommai recalled the Viveka scheme under which Rs.3,000 crore was sanctioned for 9,000 new school buildings. He said plans were also made for 30,000 schools and the appointment of two lakh teachers to ensure continuous learning for children. Stressing the importance of global competition, he urged youth to make use of libraries instead of spending time before televisions. Remembering freedom fighters like Rayanna and Kittur Rani Chennamma, Bommai called them inspirations for future generations. He also appealed for equality and social respect, noting that villages like Kadakola should serve as models of progress. The program was attended by MLA Dr. Chandru Lamani, Shirahatti Mandal President Sunil Mahantshet, and other local leaders.

NDRF funds are not being used for guarantees - CM clarifies

SUCCESS OF GUARANTEE SCHEMES HAS WORRIED BJP MEMBERS - CHIEF MINISTER SIDDARAMAIAH

Belagavi, October 4: Chief Minister Siddaramaiah said that success of guarantee schemes has worried BJP members. Congress government is doing as it said and giving guarantees without fail. He spoke to the media at the Belgaum airport. Responding to the statement of Opposition Leader R. Ashok that NDRF funds are being used for guarantees, NDRF funds are not being used for guarantees. The BJP is looking at everything with jaundiced eyes and the success of guarantee schemes has made them worried. Our guarantees have been imitated in many states including Bihar, Delhi, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana. Prime Minister Modi had said that the implementation of guarantees is not possible. But the Congress government is doing as it said and giving guarantees without fail, he said.

CM Trying to Turn a Lie into Truth on GST Compensation: MP Basavaraj Bommai

Haveri: former Chief Minister and MP Basavaraj Bommai alleged that Chief Minister Siddaramaiah is trying to turn a lie into truth by repeating it a hundred times regarding the Centre's GST compensation issue.

Speaking to the media in Haveri, he said the CM claims that Rs.11,000 crore is due from the Centre. Where is the proof for that? They have clarified this several times. Under the 15th Finance Commission, the State has received more than Rs.1 lakh crore from 2014 onwards. Every year, around Rs.3,000 crore is released at the end of the fiscal year. But Siddaramaiah never mentions what the Centre has already released.

About the stone-pelting incident in Belagavi, the former CM said there is a conspiracy by certain groups to create anarchy and violence in the country, and a few forces are supporting them. It happened earlier in Uttar Pradesh. After the Davanagere incident, they had demanded that the government bring the situation under control. Though they assured action, the police have failed to take adequate preventive measures. Looking at the incidents in Mandya and Maddur, it is clear that the law and order situation in the State has completely collapsed. There is no fear of law or police among people. The government has failed to handle several such cases. The Home Minister must take this issue seriously, otherwise it will pave the way for the country to be divided in the name of caste, religion, and community, he warned.

On being asked about the



recent floods in the State, the BJP MP said last time, the Centre released funds for flood relief, and only then did the State government disburse the money. This time, they have announced crop-loss compensation but haven't provided it yet. When he was the CM, he released twice the amount of compensation without waiting for Central funds. If they truly care about farmers, they should release the relief immediately instead of blaming the Centre.

When asked about Chief Minister Siddaramaiah's recent statement that he would remain in office for another two and a half years, Bommai said those who once didn't want him as CM must now answer whether he will continue or not. Who is responsible for driving the State into decline under his leadership? The State has become bankrupt, and no developmental works are taking place. He has asked MLAs for a list of works, but even after submitting lists, no projects are being implemented. Contractors claim that the commission rate has doubled again. Let him respond to these allegations. If he can ensure corruption-free development, then let's see whether he remains in power for two years or three.
