Kalaburagi Receives 72% Excess Rainfall; Minister Priyank Kharge Directs Emergency Relief Measures

Bengaluru, Sept. 28: Kalaburagi district has received 72% more rainfall than usual in the first 28 days of September 2025, following a 69% excess in August. In response, Kalaburagi District In-charge Minister Priyank Kharge has instructed authorities to implement emergency relief and precautionary measures immediately. After a two-day inspection of flood-affected areas, the Minister directed officials to provide temporary shelters, food supply, medicines, and ORS to affected residents. Villagers, tourists, and fishermen have been advised to avoid rivers, streams, and other water bodies due to the risk of floods and accidents. Excess water from reservoirs, including 84 lakh cusecs from Ujjani and Sina into the Bhima River, has prompted the opening of 54 care centres, with 6,664 people already relocated. Authorities are monitoring bridges, spreading awareness, and ensuring safety through local officials and rescue teams (NDRF, SDRF, FIRE).

Speaking to reporters, Ashoka said respondents should answer only questions they find suitable and avoid sharing personal documents. He alleged that the Congress is using the survey for political purposes, claiming it is not a socio-educational exercise but "Siddaramaiah's caste survey" aimed at cutting welfare schemes and ration benefits. He added that the High Court had also observed that people are not bound to answer every question. Ashoka also criticized the DMK government in Tamil Nadu over the Karur stampede, holding it responsible for failing to ensure safety despite court warnings. He said the Karnataka BJP demands a judicial probe into the incident and questioned actor Vijay for not apologizing or visiting victims. The Opposition leader further announced that he would tour Belagavi, Raichur, and Vijayapura to assess rain damage, accusing the Congress of neglecting farmers by failing to provide crop compensation.
