## Man held for cheating friend of ₹4.25 lakh in betting scam

THE city police booked two persons and arrested one of them for allegedly cheating ₹4.25 lakh from a 35-year-old man of Selvapuram on the pretext of IPL cricket betting.

The arrested was C Raja Ganesh (30) of Sakkampudur and the police are on the look out for Soundararajan of Coimbatore. Police sources said complainant S Arjunan of Selvapuram was Raja's friend for two years.

Raja had told Arjunan that he could earn in lakhs by betting on the IPL game. He told him that he would give him a separate user ID and password for betting and will instruct him when to place the bet.

He asked Arjunan to send the money to his bank account, after which he would get a user ID and password for betting. Following this, the complainant sent ₹4,25,000 in several transactions from January 2025. However, the complainant could not reach the accused by phone.

Arjunan came to know that Raja had cheated him along with another suspect Soundararajan. Based on a complaint, Selvapuram police booked a case on the two persons and arrested Raja on Tuesday. Further investigation is on.

Swindling money

Raja asked Arjunan to send the money, after which he would get a user ID and password for betting. Later, Arjunan sent ₹4.25 lakh in several transactions from January 2025 to the accused.

## Septic tank cleaning deaths: Manager, supervisor held

3 workers were killed at the dyeing unit while working sans safety gear

THE police on Wednesday arrested two employees of a private dyeing plant in Tiruppur where three workers died of suffocation while cleaning a septic tank.

The accused were Dhanabal (50) of Chinnakarai, the manager, and Aravind (47) of Palladam, the supervisor.

Sources said the tragedy hap-



pened at the Alaya Dyeing Mill in Karaipudur near Tiruppur on Monday evening. The dead were three daily wage workers engaged by Chinnasamy (36) of Sundamedu who owns a septic tank cleaning vehicle.

The Palladam police registered a case against plant owner Naveen, Chinnasamy, manager Dhanabal and supervisor Aravind. Police are searching for Naveen.

The police said Chinnasamy

will be arrested after treatment. His wife Jyothimani petitioned at the District Superintendent of Police's office stating that her husband should not be included in this case and demanded appropriate compensation to be provided to him.

Meanwhile, the VCK and various Dalit outfits have demanded the state government to provide employment to one of the family members of the victims. The victims' families have also made this request to the district administration.

THE Tamil Nadu Assembly Estimates Committee inspected various development works in

Dharmapuri district on Wednesday.

In a press statement issued by the Dharmapuri administration, Collector R Sadheesh said, "The committee members

led by Gandhirajan participated in a tree plantation in Narthampatti, Nallampalli, after which he inspected the construction of the rest house for ₹1.79 crore at the Kalabairavar Temple in Adhiyamankottai. The committee also inspected Sanathkumar River in Madhikonpalayam and the district prison building at Sogathur junction. The committee members also inspected the works being undertaken in the road between Dharmapuri - Pappapatti, under the Chief Minister Road Development Programme, for ₹19.50 crore. The committee also inspected the functioning of the Krishi Vigyan Kendra in Pappapatti where 17 farmers were provided with millet seeds worth ₹8.82 lakh."

Chief secretary of the Estimates Committee K Srinivasan was also present during the inspection and the review meeting held later.

Dharmapuri Additional Collector Cathrine Saranya and SP SS Maheswaran were also present during the proceedings.

## Leopard strikes again, kills chickens in same farmland

WEEKS after a leopard killed a dog at Vaalaihottam village near Palacode, the big cat killed a few chickens in the same farmland here on Tuesday.

On Wednesday, CCTV footage of a leopard wandering outside a house at a farmland near Valaihottam and killing chickens went viral.

Locals urged the Palacode forest range office to take steps to trap the leopard and relocate it.

Speaking to TNIE, R Vinayagam, a farmer, said, "The leopard's movement into human habitations has been increasing. Last month, the leopard came to my farmland and killed my dog. Now it has come and hunted my chickens. We are at

our wits' end and do not know what to do. Livestock are our livelihood. We urge the forest staff to take steps to relocate the leopard."

S Sivakumar, another resident, said, "The leopards have chosen our farmlands as hunting ground and are preying on our livestock. The next target could be children or people. The leopard must be relocated."

When TNIE spoke to Palacode Forest Ranger P Natraj, he said, "When the dog was hunted and killed, farmers filed a petition seeking the trapping and relocation of the leopard. We have forwarded it to the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and hope to get a reply soon. We will also report this to the PCCF and take necessary steps."

## Woman found murdered in field, gold jewellery stolen

A 60-year-old woman cattle farmer was killed by miscreants and her ear stud and nose ring weighing one sovereign were stolen near Omalur in Salem district.

The deceased was identified as Saraswathi of Kadaiyampattin village near Omalur in Salem district.

Police said Saraswathi, a widow, was living with the support of her sons and daughter. On Tuesday, she had taken cows for grazing like every other day. As she did not return home till evening, her family members went in search.

She was found dead in a pool of blood in the fields, and her body was mutilated. Upon receiving an alert, Deevattipatti police sent the body for autopsy.

Investigation revealed she was killed to rob her of the ornaments. Deputy Inspector General of Police (Salem Range) ES Uma visited the spot, and the police said special teams have been formed to nab suspects. Deevattipatti police registered a case. Probe is on.

## DMK stand on NEET baffling: Premalatha

DESIYA Murpokku Dravida Kazhagam (DMDK) leader Premalatha Vijayakant on Monday alleged the DMK has been using the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) for its political agenda.

Speaking at a party public meeting in Namakkal, she said,

"When they (DMK) took office they promised to stop conducting the NEET, but they have yet to accomplish it. Other states across the country have accepted NEET, but the DMK government is using NEET as a tool for their political agenda. Their promise to cancel NEET is confusing students and administrators across the state."

The DMDK chief also flayed

the state government for not fulfilling its promise to close TASMAR outlets. "DMK government gives ₹1,000 each to women because it knows it would return to it through TASMAR. It had promised to reduce the number of TASMAR outlets but contrary to its promise, it is opening more outlets. Not a single TASMAR outlet has been closed," she added.

## Three arrested for attempting to hunt wild animals within Chennampatti forest range

THREE persons out to hunt wild animals were arrested by officials of the Chennampatti forest range in Erode district on Tuesday. An unlicensed country-made gun, five bullets and knives among others were seized from them.

The accused were identified as S Mathesh (40) and P Mathesh (41) of Ennamangalam in Anthiyur and Vellingiri (37) of Kongadai in Bargur hills.

Sources said a team of personnel from the Chennampatti forest range on patrol around Malayanur Lake on Tuesday found the trio in the forest with



a country-made gun.

The forest department arrested them and confiscated their weapons after they revealed during questioning they had entered the forest for hunt-

ing. Chennampatti Forest Ranger Raja said, "They were carrying an unlicensed country-made gun to hunt. They have no previous criminal records. Further probe is on."

## ₹1.43L unaccounted money recovered from RTO checkpoint

DVAC sleuths conducted a surprise raid on the RTO checkpoint at Kaalikovil and recovered ₹1.43 lakh in cash on Wednesday. The action followed a tip-off that officials at the checkpoint were allowing vehicles to cross the Tamil Nadu border without checks and issuing temporary passes after receiving hefty bribes.

The DVAC personnel were informed that RTO officials don't impose fines on errant vehicles and let them pass.

Unaccounted ₹1.43 lakh in cash was seized from Motor Vehicle Inspector S Syed Jawad Ahmed. He is being questioned by DVAC sleuths.
