Shiv Sena to Contest All 80 Wards in Upcoming Udaipur Municipal Elections; New District Office Inaugurated

UDAIPUR, 8 OCT

Rajput Mahasabha to Host Collective Karwa Chauth Celebration

UDAIPUR, 8 OCT
The Rajput Mahasabha Seva Sansthan, Udaipur division, will organize the community's first-ever collective Karwa Chauth celebration. The decision was finalized during a meeting at the organization's office in Rawji Ka Hata. General Secretary Pradeep Singh Bhati informed that eight couples have already registered, each contributing ₹1,011 as participation fees. Office bearer Dalpat Singh Chahan said the event aims to promote unity within the community while easing financial expenses for families. Each couple may invite up to 50 guests, with the Rajput Mahasabha providing additional costs. President Sant Singh Bhati invited all community members to support and participate in the initiative. The meeting was attended by office bearers including Bhagwant Singh Krishnavat, Manohar Singh Jhala, and other executive members.

Shiv Sena announced that it will contest all 80 wards in the forthcoming Udaipur Municipal Corporation elections. The announcement was made during the inauguration of the party's new district office near Rangbhawan, Surajpol. The ribbon-cutting ceremony was conducted by Shiv Sena Rajasthan state president Prahlad Singh Paldhari and newly appointed Udaipur district president Rajesh Vaishnav.

Speaking at the event, Paldhari said he is on a two-day visit to the Udaipur division to meet party workers, gather feedback, and announce district presidents in various regions to strengthen the party's organizational structure.

District president Rajesh Vaishnav criticized the previous administration, alleging



that over the past 30 years, the BJP has neglected city development. He cited the Ayad River project, claiming crores were spent to convert it into a

"Venice-like" river, but it ended up reduced to a mere narrow drain. Vaishnav emphasized that Shiv Sena will work to make Udaipur clean,

healthy, encroachment-free, and properly developed.

Regarding election strategy, Vaishnav said the party may consider seat-sharing

with the BJP on 10 wards if the latter agrees; otherwise, Shiv Sena will contest all 80 wards independently. The event also featured

social initiatives: Divyang (differently-abled) citizen Kishore Gameti received a tricycle, provided by party members including Vijay Patel, Jagdish Prajapat, Chetan Kumawat, and others. Additionally, Shiv Sena launched an ambulance service for the needy, which will be operated by Chahal Goods Cargo, reflecting the party's commitment to public welfare. To further strengthen the organization, an 11-member core committee for the Udaipur division has been formed to manage both election preparations and organizational activities. The new office will remain open daily from 9 AM to 10 PM for public grievances, allowing citizens to directly interact with the party. The inauguration was attended by senior party leaders, activists, representatives of social organizations, and numerous prominent citizens.

Former CM Ashok Gehlot Welcomed on Arrival

Devotees who arrived for morning prayers discovered the damaged idol and found jewelry items scattered around the shrine. On receiving the information, Bhopalpara police reached the spot and covered the broken idol with cloth. With the assistance

of the priest and devotees, the area was cleaned and arrangements were made to place the Bheruji idol safely. Bhopalpara police station in-charge, Adarsh Kumar, stated that the Bheruji idol is made of Molela clay and a portion of its face was found broken in the morning. The authorities are investigating whether the damage was deliberate or caused by an animal. CCTV footage from the vicinity is being examined to determine the exact cause of the incident.

Pilot Slams State Over Delayed Panchayat Elections

Former Rajasthan Deputy Chief Minister and Congress leader Sachin Pilot arrived in Udaipur on Wednesday evening, where he was warmly welcomed by Congress workers at the Circuit House. Speaking on the occasion, Pilot said that the Congress party has carefully chosen its candidate for the Anta Assembly seat by-election and is confident of winning. He emphasized that elections are a contest of ideologies and parties, and that Pramod Jain Bhaya, the experienced candidate, will fight a strong campaign.



The former PCC chief criticized the state government, saying that the public of Rajasthan want to send a message nationwide that the government is not performing. "Promises made to the public have been broken, and people respond accordingly," he added. State Government Unable to Conduct Panchayat Elections Pilot highlighted that the BJP-led state government has failed to conduct Panchayat Raj elections. He said, "If the government had performed well, they would have no reason to fear today. The public is an-

gry, and the government will face severe consequences. Whenever Panchayat Raj elections are held, Congress will win a massive mandate." Public Trust Broken in 2 Years Sachin Pilot further criticized the government for failing the people over the past two years, citing issues such as road accidents, flood mismanagement, hospital fires, and tanker mishaps. "The government's credibility in Rajasthan is over, and the people's dreams have been shattered," he said. Pilot traveled from Ajmer to Udaipur by car, stayed overnight in the city, and is scheduled to visit Sirohi the following day.

Udaipur to Face Widespread Power Outage Tomorrow Due to Maintenance Work

Udaipur residents are set to experience power cuts across more than 100 areas on Thursday, October 9, as the Aljmer Electricity Distribution Corporation conducts scheduled maintenance work. According to the assistant engineer of the electricity department, the electricity supply in the affected areas will be suspended from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., causing an eight-hour disruption for households and businesses.

The maintenance campaign is aimed at improving the city's power infrastructure, but several posh colonies, commercial areas, and residential neighborhoods will face temporary inconvenience. Citizens are advised to make necessary arrangements for uninterrupted power needs and take precautions during the outage period.

Electricity officials have requested the public's understanding and cooperation while the work is underway, emphasizing that the temporary inconvenience will help ensure more reliable power supply in the future.
