

AP: Naidu asks TDP leaders to explain benefits of GST reforms to people



Vijayawada, Sep 28 (UNI) Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu today directed ministers, MPs, and MLAs to ensure the success of the GST 2.0 Utsav by organising campaigns until October 19 to raise awareness among the people about the benefits of GST 2.0 reforms. He told them that the poor and middle-class will benefit significantly from these reforms. As part of the campaign, sixty thousand meetings should be conducted, and ministers and MLAs should interact

with 1.60 crore families to explain the advantages of GST reforms. The Chief Minister held a teleconference with ministers, MPs, and MLAs.

Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Minister said that with the GST reforms, the prices of essential commodities have come down, benefiting the common man. He asked party workers to make the GST Utsav as successful as the International Yoga Day celebrations. He told them that due to the reforms, the state government was able to save Rs

1,000 crore in the power sector. The previous government had destroyed the power sector, and, by purchasing power at higher prices, imposed a heavy burden on consumers. He stressed that party leaders should explain to the people the achievements of the state government in the power sector.

Naidu mentioned that the NDA Government has fulfilled the 'Super Six' welfare schemes and is implementing several welfare schemes as assured. He emphasised that it is the responsibility of party leaders to explain these welfare programmes to the common man. Leaders should interact with the people to instil confidence in them, he said, adding that if leaders win the confidence of the people, the NDA government can win elections at any time. Naidu made it clear that he would recognise only hardworking party workers and that there was no place for those who merely tried to impress him with words. He accused the opposition YSRCP of resorting to a false campaign, saying its MLAs were not attending Assembly sessions and were spreading misinformation. He called on party leaders to explain to the people the true attitude of YSRCP leaders.

1.41 lakh people provided free medical treatment under Health Scheme: Minister

Vijayawada, Sep 28 (UNI) The Andhra Pradesh Government has provided Rs 996 crore worth medical treatment to over 1.41 lakh people under NTR Vaidya Seva scheme till September 26.

Health Minister Satya Kumar Yadav said on Sunday that the administration is committed to provide the best medical treatment to the poor at free of cost under the NTR Vaidya Seva scheme. Diagnosis for heart diseases is conducted to the beneficiaries to avoid the patient's life threats. He made it clear that the Government is providing basic amenities in the government hospitals.

"By providing timely medical treatment during the golden hour period, the lives of 3,402



patients were saved for which the Government has spent Rs 7 crore," the Health Minister asserted.

"Since June, 2024, 19,61,257

people have received treatment through NTR Vaidya Seva scheme for which the Government has spent Rs 5,562 crore. Out of the 19,61,257 people, 1,41,315 people were treated for heart problems. The Naidu-headed coalition Government has provided treatment worth Rs 996.20 crore to them," the Health Minister revealed, adding that of these, 45,986 underwent stents, 9,880 underwent bypass surgeries and 3,074 underwent valve replacements. As many as 69,926 cancer patients were being provided medical treatment under the scheme, he noted, stating that the Government made available the Golden Hour medical treatment in 238 hospitals across the state.

AP: ERC order exposes Naidu's lies: Ex-Minister

Nellore, Sep 28 (UNI) YSRCP senior leader and former Minister Kakani Goverdhan Reddy today came down heavily on the Chandrababu Naidu-led coalition Government, calling the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (APERC) order a "tight slap" to Naidu's misrule.

Kakani said that in 2024-25, Discoms proposed Rs 2,758.76 crore in true-up charges, but APERC approved only Rs 1,863.64 crore, rejecting inflated claims. Discoms had shown power purchase costs at Rs 5.84-Rs. 5.89 per unit, while ERC approved only Rs.5.27, adding that transmission and distribution losses projected at 10.17% were cut to 9.87%. Despite this, Discoms illegally collected Rs 2,787.18 crore (Rs. 0.40 per unit). The ERC has now ordered a refund of Rs. 923.55 crore in 12 instalments at Rs. 0.13 per unit, he stated.

The Former Minister lamented that the consumers were already burdened with Rs. 6,072.86 crore in November 2024 and another Rs. 9,412.50 crore in January 2025 bills. Till March 2025, people were looted in the name of excess charges. "YSRCP never violated ERC norms nor imposed illegal burdens, which is why no ERC reprimand ever came during

Jagan's tenure," he claimed.

The former Minister called Chandrababu's Assembly claims 'blatant lies'. Naidu falsely claimed construction of 6.15 lakh houses is in progress, the construction of 3 lakh has been completed and the enhanced subsidies for the BC/SC/STs are untrue.

"In contrast, YSRCP spent Rs 32,909 crore, giving Rs 2.70 lakh support per house, including free sand, steel, and cement. Nearly 2 lakh TIDCO houses were given to the poor at Rs 1 each, whereas Chandrababu's plan forced families into EMIs of Rs.3,000 per month for 20 years," Kakani Goardhan Reddy lashed out.

Highlighting YSRCP's achievements, the former Minister said 71,811 acres were acquired for housing layouts, 17,005 new colonies were developed, and land worth Rs. 76,000 crore was given to the poor.

Ex-Minister Kakani Govardhan Reddy asserted: "Chandrababu Naidu's rule is about looting people through inflated power bills and housing scams, while YSRCP under Jagan Mohan Reddy delivered dignity, houses, and justice to the poor. The ERC order has unmasked the lies and loot of Naidu's government."

AP: Krishna, Godavari rivers in spate, 2nd warning issue at Prakasam barrage

Vijayawada, Sep 28 (UNI) The Krishna and Godavari rivers are in spate in Andhra Pradesh with heavy inflows and a second warning was issued at Prakasam barrage here on Sunday and two persons washed away in the flood water of Godavari at Rajahmundry. Official sources said that the river Krishna is receiving 6.05 lakh cusecs of water. The 69 crest gates of Prakasam bar-

rage were lifted to discharge the flood water downstream into the sea. Warning signal two was issued at Prakasam barrage and people living downstream were warned of inundation. The officials set up control rooms at Kolluru and Bhattiprolu to provide information on the flood situation. Meanwhile, the river Godavari is also in spate with heavy inflow.
